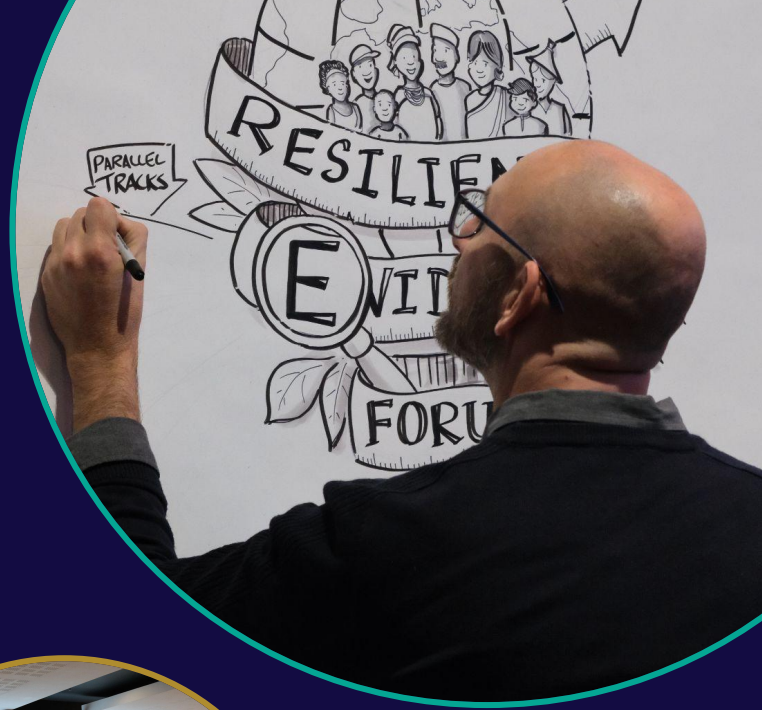

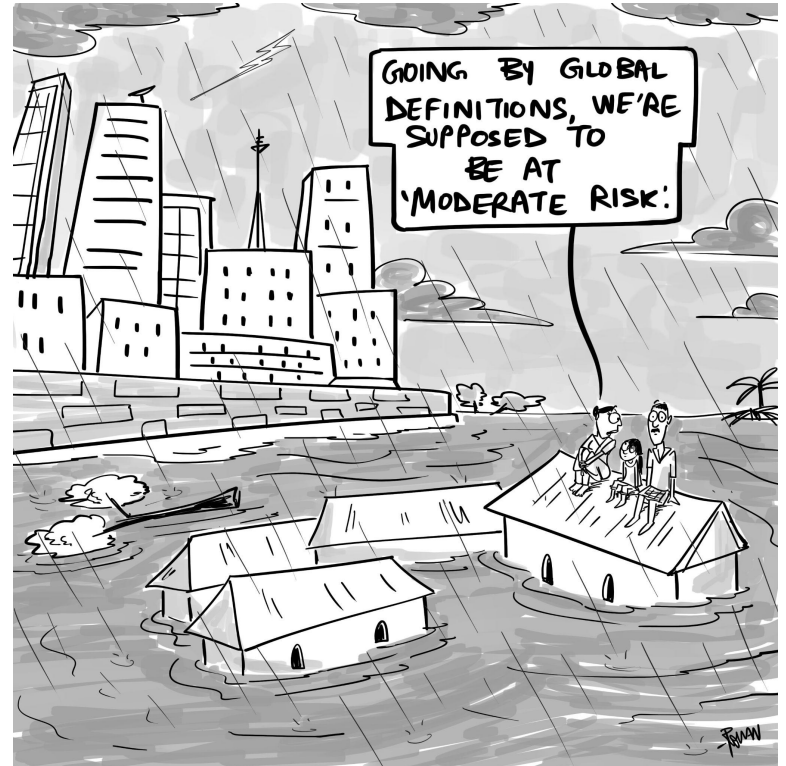

# Key Messages

There has been an expansion in the definitions of resilience evidence, what counts as evidence, and whose evidence counts.

- **What counts as evidence:** increased recognition of the importance of mixed-methods, combining quantitative methods and qualitative methods.
- **Whose evidence counts:** as lived experiences and local and Indigenous knowledge are increasingly recognised as core to evidence-building processes.



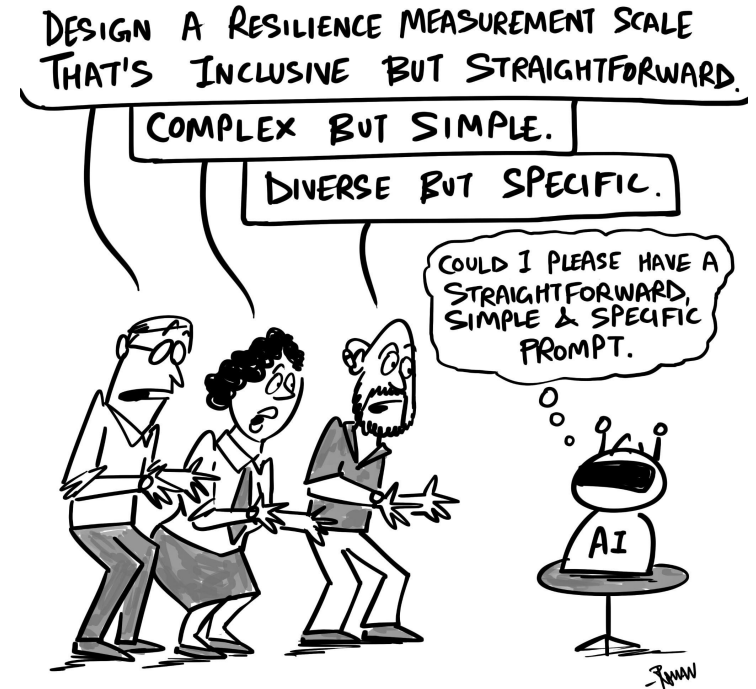
